Crime

View from the Pew

Look deeper into the Bible though, the pattern that emerges is not one of God sat in Heaven (wherever that is) looking down via CCTV; rather, it is of a loving parent, intimately involved in nudging, shaping and fashioning this world, even with all of its strife and strikes.

'Do not be afraid ... for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you'.

Faith is sometimes not so much an acceptance of God's existence, rather it is an awareness of his presence, in the world, in the turmoil, calming the storms, bringing the words of peace that resolve conflict.

Emmanuel, God with us, Jesus Christ himself said, 'I will be with you always, even to the end of the age'.

Perhaps when watching the news, instead of being overwhelmed by what is dark and fearful, we might strive to see the patches of light and hope where God continues to be at work in the world that is still in his hands.

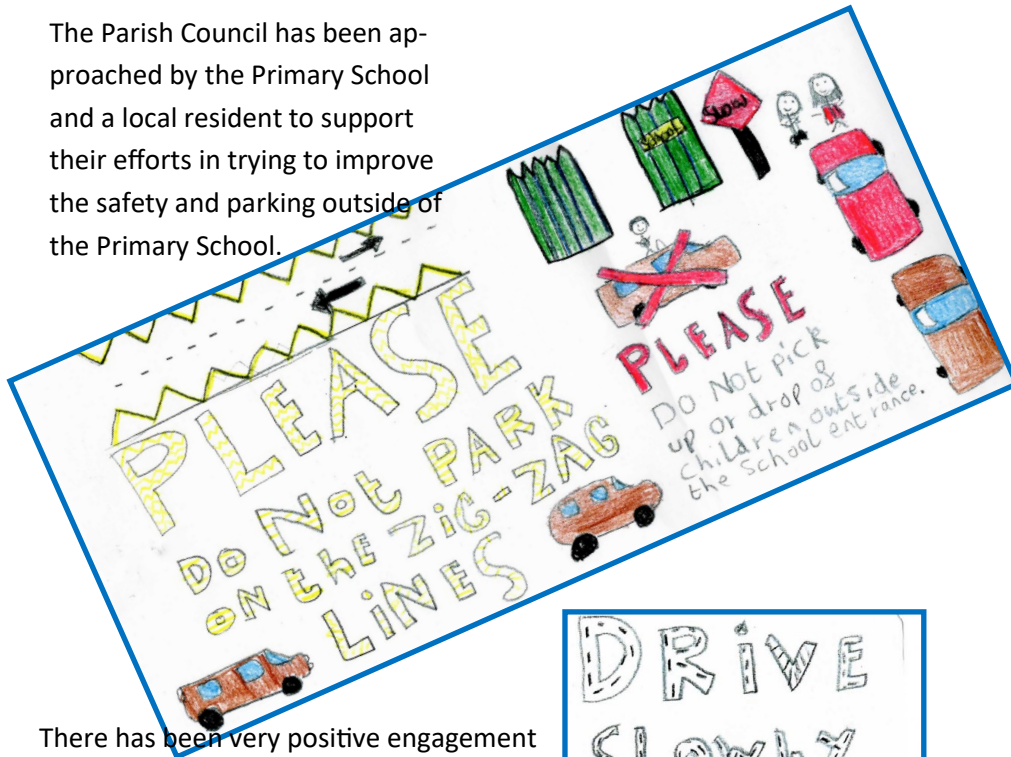

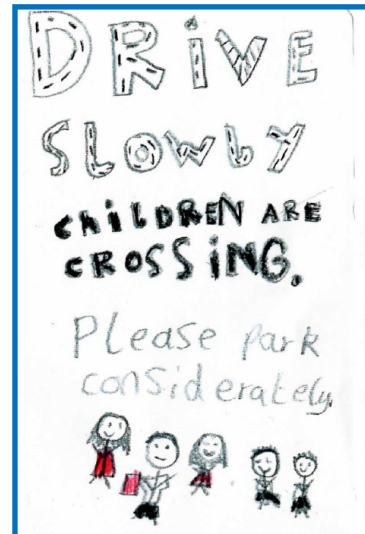
