New council member

The Parish Council has coopted a new member to fill one of its vacancies and so welcome to Cllr. David McIntyre.

Highways/footpaths

Positive actions were being taken by both the Primary School, Ward Cllrs. and a local resident with regard to improving parking outside of the Primary School and a new barrier had been installed and the Parish Council had agreed to purchase a road safety sign as part of the scheme with the School purchasing the other sign. Councillors were pleased with the commitment from both the school and the resident concerned in bringing this matter to some progress.

POLICE REPORT

Wolds Ward Healing Update JuLY 2023

Crime

There were thirty seven reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during June. The following offences were reported in Healing.

Between 24th May and 6th June offenders used a ladder to gain access to a property on Stallingborough Road. Once inside, they let other persons into the property. The property was searched, jewellery was stolen, and food was smeared over furniture. Two persons have been arrested.

Other crimes include:

Two assaults. One report of harassment which is race related. One minor public order incident.

One report of sharing inappropriate images on social media.

There was one report of ASB which was of cars racing round the EuroParc.


