**Highways and Footpaths**

NELC is looking at a village-wide plan to address traffic issues within the Village and has already consulted with the Parish Council on improvements and changes to the layout of the bus stop on Low Road.

A meeting with the Bowling Club has been organised to discuss the season for 2021 and the green has continued to receive its usual treatments during the winter. Grass cutting will now start on all sites throughout the village. The Council also had a site visit in Porri's Wood and some works were commissioned at the site as a result of that visit. Fencing repairs were also sanctioned at the Moated Site. Ongoing inspections continue to be held at all sites owned and/or managed by the Council.

## POLICE REPORT

### Wolds Ward Healing Update March 2021

#### **Crime**

There were 21 reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during February, of which four have occurred in Healing.

As previously reported, there have been two reports involving malicious communications.

During the evening of 3<sup>rd</sup> February, four men from the Scunthorpe [area](#) were arrested following a report of them being on site acting suspiciously at a factory on EuroParc.

The fourth report relates to sending inappropriate photos over social media.

Into March, there has been one report for Healing to date which was a minor public order incident on the EuroParc.

There have been three reports of ASB, two regarding the play park on Wisteria Drive and a neighbour dispute.

Your local Neighbourhood Policing Team appreciates the importance of being in the right place, at the right time, for the right reasons to reassure the public, improve public confidence and reduce crime and anti-social behaviour in the area in which we all live and work.

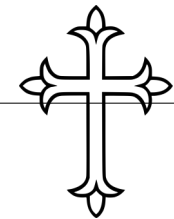

# Healing's Hedgehog Highway



## THE HEDGHOGS NEED OUR HELP!

Healing Village is home to the humble hedgehog, and we are very lucky to have them around as their numbers are declining rapidly in the wild. One of the most common reasons is because of them having to travel across roads and urbanised areas when foraging, causing fatal collisions or difficulty finding food in non-wild environments.

So, we're asking *you* to help us in a big community project we are calling the 'Healing Hedgehog Highway' – an alternative safe passage that spans all across Healing, providing the many miles needed that the Hedgehogs need to forage on a regular basis.



## HOW CAN I HELP?

To be involved in this exciting endeavour all you need to do is simply cut a small hole in your fence or remove a brick from your wall (a small passage around 13x13cm, or about the size of a CD will do) to enable the hedgehog's safe access to the next garden, linking all of our gardens together. You could also dig under a fence to make a tunnel access. But please avoid making holes that lead onto roads. This will help them to avoid crossing roads and make it easier for them to forage for food and water.



Encouraging hedgehogs into your garden also will help to control the bugs in your garden as hedgehogs' diets mainly consist of insects, so it's a perfect way to rid your garden of any unwanted creepy crawlies naturally.

### View from the pew

On February 28<sup>th</sup> 2021, a family heard a thud in their drive in the middle of the night. When they looked in the morning, the drive was scattered with pieces of volcanic rock. The father of the family gathered the pieces up in a bag. Later in the day, a scientist who had been part of a team monitoring the progress of a meteorite, located the place where it had fallen. The scientists were excited because the rock was made up of carbonaceous chondrite, a material which has unaltered chemistry from the formation of our solar system 4.6 billion years ago. In studying it they could learn to understand its beginning.

Facts like the information about the meteorite stretch our imagination. We can hardly comprehend the time scale of 4.6 billion years ago. We are much more comfortable with facts which seem more simple to cope with. Yet we have an inbuilt wonder about the nature of the whole world around us. How can we really imagine that our bodies are made up of lots of cells all whizzing round, which are integral to our functioning in our daily lives?

What about our thoughts about consciousness – what is it, how does it start in living things, and what happens when it ends with death? Is there a spiritual creative power behind everything? We are celebrating Easter Sunday on April 4<sup>th</sup>, and the events which led Jesus' disciples to experience His coming back to life after He had died on the Cross. This is the Good News of the Christian faith. Jesus was sent by God, the spiritual power behind the universe, to show us what God is like – He has unending love for us whom He has created. Through prayer, people can communicate with God - who is an integral part of everything.

The faith is that if we do wrong and feel separate from God, He goes on loving us, whom He has created. All we have to do is come just as we are, ask for forgiveness, and we can know a heavenly peace. This is the message of Easter – for all God's children everywhere!

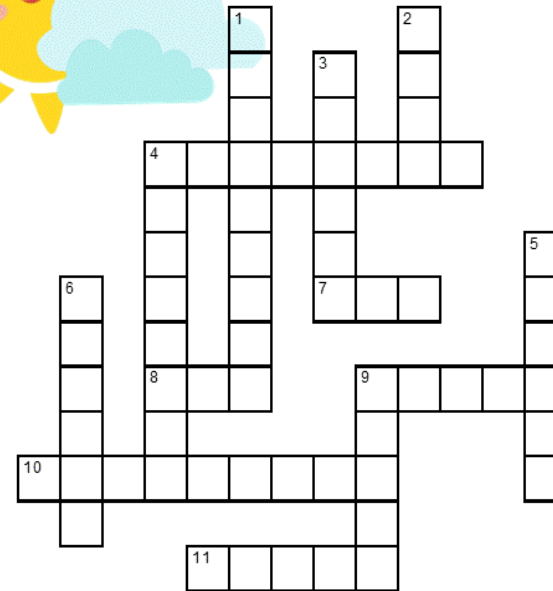
