View from the Pew: It's A Wonderful World

I was recently prevented from leading a funeral because I contracted Covid the day before the service was scheduled. This caused me much sadness because I detest letting people down at the best of times, and funerals are not typically regarded as the best of times. Mercifully, two angels stepped in and the service went ahead as scheduled. The entry music at the Crematorium was 'What A Wonderful World' by Louis Armstrong. As I write this, the world is watching in shock as Russia continues to pulverise all within its reach in the Ukraine; it doesn't feel much like a wonderful world at the minute.

When Armstrong recorded that track in August 1967, his health was failing; he was suffering from heart disease and was having breathing difficulties. This 'wonderful world' contains so much sadness, illness, death, war and destruction. Nations have barely emerged from a global pandemic ... and now this? Despair, etched onto the faces of fleeing Ukrainians, is mirrored in our own hearts, for it is humanity that is hurting in the same way that an injured foot causes distress to the whole body. And yet ... it is a wonderful world, as demonstrated by the outpouring of compassion in response to aid appeals. It is a wonderful world that God has made; there is so much that is good, true, beautiful, amusing, happy and lovely. In creating the world, God declared it to be 'good', and it is; the freshness of Spring, the lushness of Summer, the splendour of Autumn and the crispness of Winter. Reflecting on all that is good, and believing that nothing can ultimately thwart the plans of the God who is nudging all things in the direction of wholeness and harmony, this is hope, hope that counters the despair that assails us even as we pray in hope for good to triumph over evil in the Ukraine. May you think to yourself, as I think to myself ... it's a wonderful world.
