

The Hall has now reopened for the majority of its indoor classes etc. The only things not yet allowed are private parties/children's parties etc. These should be back in from w/c 19th July if the Government's road map is adhered to.

### Village Hall project

The building of the new project will commence late July/early August and take approximately 3 to 3 1/2 months to complete. Whilst building works are taking place, the existing Hall is being made available to the Parish Council for its regular hirings to continue uninterrupted. The Council is now sourcing extra funding for the project due to the exceptional circumstances surrounding the cost and availability of materials due to the global pandemic, with prices anticipated to rise by around 25% in some areas.

### **Finance**

The Parish Council has now completed and signed off its Annual Return for the external auditors and has submitted the required documentation.






July village walk

- . Fit smoke alarms to the ceiling on every level in your home.
- . Install a smoke alarm in the bedroom if your child sleeps on a bunk bed or high
- · Do not leave your child alone when cooking.
- · Always keep matches and lighters out of reach of children.
- Educate your child to turn off and unplug electrical items such as game consoles, TV, mobile phone chargers etc. when they sleep or when they are not using them.

- The best escape route is the usual way in and out of your home
- Have a backup plan in the event your first escape route is blocked.
- Practice your escape plan with everyone in your household.

### Burns advice...Treat burns and scalds as soon as possible to limit the damage to the skin.

- Cool the burn with cool or lukewarm water for 10 to 30 minutes, ideally within 20 minutes of the injury occurring. Never use ice, iced water or any creams or greasy substances such as butter.
- Cover with cling film or a clean plastic bag after the burn has been cooled. If no plastic film is available, use a sterile dressing or non-fluffy material
- Keep your child warm, use a blanket or layers of clothing, but avoid putting them on the injured area. Seek medical advice.
