HEALING PARISH COUNCIL NOTES FOR JULY 2021

The Council meeting for July 2021 was held in person for the first time in over a year. The Hall is a Covid-secure venue and residents are welcome to attend the meetings once again.

Highways and Footpaths

NELC is still working on further plans for easing traffic congestion in the village, especially around the schools and some works are already in the programme but there are more to follow. A quarterly meeting was held in June with the team rep from NELC. An additional bus shelter has been requested by the Parish Council on Stallingborough Road to provide some shelter for residents and the Council has requested a wooden one. This hopefully will be added to NELC's forward programme for 2022.

Proposal: Erect porch to front elevation with alterations to windows, loft conversion to provide additional accommodation at second floor to include alterations to the height and pitch of roof, install front and rear dormers and various alterations including roof lights

Proposal: Erect single storey rear extension with roof lights to existing garage to form pool room, retain play equipment to rear of garden, erect porch to front elevation and alterations to boundary treatments to include installation of gate

There has also been some ivy ringing carried out on the trees at the Moated Site and there is some further tree work due in Porri's Wood when school holidays commence.

Parish Council Vacancies

Village Hall

The Hall has now reopened for the majority of its indoor classes etc. The only things not yet allowed are private parties/children's parties etc. These should be back in from w/c 19th July if the Government's road map is adhered to.

Village Hall project

The building of the new project will commence late July/early August and take approximately 3 to 3 1/2 months to complete. Whilst building works are taking place, the existing Hall is being made available to the Parish Council for its regular hirings to continue uninterrupted. The Council is now sourcing extra funding for the project due to the exceptional circumstances surrounding the cost and availability of materials due to the global pandemic, with prices anticipated to rise by around 25% in some areas.

The Parish Council has now completed and signed off its Annual Return for the external auditors and has submitted the required documentation.

They tell us that it has been far more rewarding and enjoyable than they could ever have imagined it would be, as over time the volunteers begin to realise the hugely positive impact of their role on the people they support.

Our volunteers have also benefitted from an increased knowledge and understanding of how dementia affects people's daily lives and the small steps that can be taken to help people maintain their well-being and independence through social interactions that the rest of us take for granted.

Police and Crime Plan consultation

This week I formally started the process of developing the new statutory Police and Crime Plan for the Humber, which will cover the period 2021-2024.

This is an important document that will not only set out the police and crime objectives for the Humber and the policing that the Chief Constable of Humberside Police is to provide, but also how statutory and non-statutory organisations across the area will work together to deliver safer communities and support the victims and witnesses of crime and antisocial behaviour.

I want to ensure that the plan is developed and delivered in the spirit of collaboration, with input from organisations and residents from across the area. I therefore wanted to make you aware of this work to ensure you have the opportunity to comment on issues in your local areas and to ask for your help in raising awareness with your residents.

I have launched a public survey, which will run until Sunday 11 July, to gather people's views and experiences from across the area. The more people who complete it the better the information will be, so if you could help me to raise awareness of it (such as through social media or any residents' newsletters you may have coming up) that would be greatly appreciated. 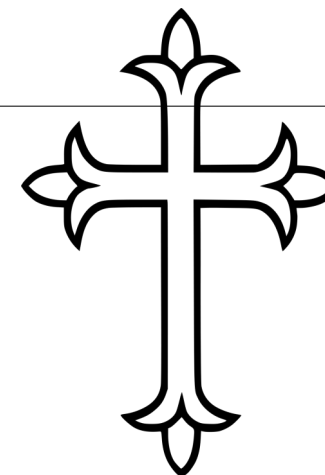

Keep Children Safe

IA-CFS1

Have an effective plan



Prevent it...

- Fit smoke alarms to the ceiling on every level in your home.
- Install a smoke alarm in the bedroom if your child sleeps on a bunk bed or high sleeper.
- Do not leave your child alone when cooking.
- Always keep matches and lighters out of reach of children.
- Educate your child to turn off and unplug electrical items such as game consoles, TV, mobile phone chargers etc. when they sleep or when they are not using them.

Plan...

- The best escape route is the usual way in and out of your home.
- Have a backup plan in the event your first escape route is blocked.
- Practice your escape plan with everyone in your household.

Burns advice... Treat burns and scalds as soon as possible to limit the damage to the skin.

- Cool the burn with cool or lukewarm water for 10 to 30 minutes, ideally within 20 minutes of the injury occurring. Never use ice, iced water or any creams or greasy substances such as butter.
- Cover with cling film or a clean plastic bag after the burn has been cooled. If no plastic film is available, use a sterile dressing or non-fluffy material.
- Keep your child warm, use a blanket or layers of clothing, but avoid putting them on the injured area. Seek medical advice.

HEALING GARDEN CLUB

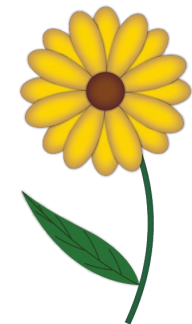
The Garden Club intend, government guidelines permitting, to reinstate The Annual Late Summer Show on September 2nd2021 with the venue to be announced.

By 8.30am track and Trace had rung us to go through all the people Lucy had been in contact with and at 11.30am NLDC came round to see if we needed any help even offering to find someone to take the dog for a walk.

We are not getting rid of this virus we are managing it, so its effects are not so devastating as they have been in the past. While everyone has the right to do as they think fit it does annoy me when people flout the laws set up to protect them after all Lucy pick this virus up from someone or something it did not just appear out of no where and while we have been abiding by what the law requires some do not.
