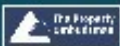

The Council meeting for May was held in the new Village Hall at the slightly later time of 7.30 pm.

The May meeting is the Annual Parish Council meeting for Healing Parish Council and it saw Cllr. Paul Fieldgate elected as Chairman once again. The Council also reviewed all of its policies and procedures at this meeting.

Highways and Footpaths

Proposals had now been received from NELC over traffic calming measures around the Primary School and these were now being sent out to residents by NELC as part of a full consultation. The Parish Council had welcomed the proposals but would also be waiting to see residents' comments on the proposals and then liaise again with NELC over the findings before any actions are taken.

POLICE REPORT

Wolds Ward Healing Update May 2022

Crime

There were forty four reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during April, of which five have occurred in Healing.

Overnight 13th & 14th April plant vehicles including a Telehandler, generator, and roller, along with a water pump, with a combined value of about £93,000 was stolen from the pumping station on The Avenue.

A male has been charged with fraud and dealt with for several traffic offences after he put false registration plates on his vehicle to make it appear it was fully legal to drive on the road.

Other crime include:

Harassment whereby a female has been dealt with by way of caution. A public order incident.

There have been three reports of ASB.

Youths causing issues on the Royal British Legion site.

Parking issues at Healing School on Great Coates Road.

One neighbour dispute.

View from the Pew

Do you ever stop to think how on earth all the information stored in your brain can possibly be a reality? That such a small part of a body can contain all the information that is needed for living? That it can retain all the memories of a lifetime? That it can contain all the instructions needed to do all the things that control the way we behave?

Surely there must be a creative power behind it all? Surely it can't all be just a random happening? It has been the belief of people through the ages that somehow there must be more than just the things we see and experience; there must be a cause behind it all. But what? And what is that cause like? Is it a brutal selfish power, or is it a caring entity? Does it control those it has made, or are they free to choose the way they behave? People have a name for this power – God.

The terrible things being enacted in the Ukraine at the moment evoke the above kind of questioning. How can a loving God allow such brutality? How can those who have put their faith in a caring God reconcile what is happening to them with a faith in which love is involved? One of the explanations which bring some comfort is that people have the choice in how they behave, and this can be very selfish and brutal.

I have a little book in which there are some sermons written by my grandfather. The theme of many of them is that the troubles of this world are temporary – that after death there is another world in which the love shown by Jesus Christ will be paramount. That is one way of looking at things. An alternative view is that we are all called to make heaven on earth by living out the love of Jesus in everything we do, underpinned by the power of prayer.

Let us make living by love the very centre of our lives!

PARKS NEWS AND UPDATES

The summer maintenance programme is now commencing and grass cutting on both the parks and the bowling green will be in full swing during the coming months.

The tennis court nets are back in place and the court surface has been swept and cleaned.

There is no news yet on our Lottery Funding bid but we will keep residents updated via the Newsletter and our social media.

We will be doing the first inspection of the year during late May/early June which looks at all of the sites owned and/or managed by the Council. A tree specialist goes around with the Clerk and the Chairman and any works recommended are reported back to the Council for consideration. Work to trees etc. is prioritised around tree health and safety issues.

The Parish Council controls and manages the parks on Fords Avenue and Poplar Road. It also owns land at Cornflower Close and also to the end of Quantock Gardens and also leases Porri's Wood from NELC and manages the woodland there. The Parish Council also owns the Chapel Footpath between Station Road and The Avenue.

NELC support the parks maintenance and an invoice for the previous financial year to recoup some funding has already been made.
