

The Council meeting for October 2021 was held and enough members were in attendance to make the meeting quorate.

Council Member Numbers

A proposal was put on the table to reduce the quorum for meetings to 3—it currently stands at 4. This is due to the current low number of members, which is just 5. This motion will be voted on at the November meeting for clarification.

Planning Applications

The planning applications considered at the meeting for the last meeting were as follows:

DM/0977/21/FUL 12A The Avenue, healing

Proposal: Erect single storey rear extension and erect first floor extension over existing garage with roof lights

No objections.

DM/0930/21/FULA 11 Carlton Road, Healing

Proposal: Demolish existing outbuilding attached to dwelling and erect a single storey extension with rooflight and two storey extension with alterations to rear

No objections.

It was also agreed that representatives attend either the November or December meeting of the Parish Council to update on the latest plans for the proposed solar farm at Aylesby.

Remembrance (View from the Pew)

November - the month for Remembrance.

What is Remembrance all about? It involves all the emotions we have — but perhaps one way of putting it is a mixture of joy and grief.
What does grieving involve? It is an emotion which perhaps we dread because of the inward hurt with which we have to deal. We all deal with it in our own way. Some people just collapse into a helpless morass in which ordinary functioning is just impossible. Some people adopt the stiff upper lip, and carry on quashing their feelings until suddenly it all wells up and will not be denied. Often it is a significant anniversary which triggers this state of emotion. Some people manage their grief by acknowledging the hurt, but finding comfort in that they are carrying out the wishes of the person who is no longer present in the flesh. There is a saying "time is a great healer", and many people find that they regain the ability to live normally as time goes on. That is when the joy comes into play. The great thing about happy memories is that nothing can change what has been a joy in life.

Another factor is to have a faith in an after-life, when we will meet again. People describe their experiences of the authenticity which give this hope. Recently I read about a lady who had a near-death experience whilst on the operating table. She saw all her relations, and among them there was a little boy. She asked who he was, and was told he was her little boy who had died at birth, but was continuing his growth in heaven.

The life, death and resurrection of Jesus is a big key to dealing with our grief. His spiritual Presence which we can find through prayer, can transform our whole being with His spiritual comfort.

So let us give thanks for our memories, give thanks for all those whose dedication and sacrifice for a just cause is one of the most praise-worthy things in human experience, and for our God, whose love sustains us through all our lives.



Bonfires and Fireworks

Keep everyone at a safe distance



Never go back to a Ilt firework



We actively encourage the public to attend an organised display



- Keep everyone at a safe distance from the fire
- Bonfires should be on open ground at least 15 metres away from houses, fences, sheds, trees or overhead cables etc. Always keep bonfires small
- Always check bonfires for nesting animals and other wildlife before lighting
- Whoever is supervising the fire should not drink alcohol
- Never leave bonfires unattended
- Water should be readily available to control the fire. If the fire becomes out of control call 999 immediately and ask for the fire service
- Never use accelerants on a bonfire, i.e. petrol, paraffin or aerosols
