Membership changes

Cllr Norton has now stepped down from the Parish Council due to time commitments but with two new members coopted in September, the Council now is at a membership of 6 with 4 vacancies.

Highways/footpaths

Residents should see more visible and frequent parking enforcement visits in the village with new shift patterns now in place and a collaboration with the Parish Council which will see the teams being able to use the facilities at the Village Hall to carry out shift-handovers etc. This will enable them to spend more time in the Village on a regular basis.

POLICE REPORT

Wolds Ward Healing Update October 2023

Crime

There were sixty one reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during September. The following offences were reported in Healing. Overnight 27th & 28th September, an integral garage at a property on Wisteria Drive was entered. A childs quad bike and cycle were stolen.

Overnight 16th & 17th September an attempt was made to steal a motorbike parked at a factory on the EuroParc. Damage was caused to the bike in the attempt.

Between 22nd & 24th September, one motorbike was stolen and an attempt to steal two other bikes was made from factories on EuroParc.

Two trees were chopped down in Healing Church Yard. Damage was caused to a conservatory roof after an object was thrown on to it.

Other crimes include: Six assaults. Three reports of harassment. Three public order incidents

There were no reports of ASB.

Parks and Land Management

The Council is now putting in place a management plan for the Moated Site and most of the sheep have now been removed by the farmer. When the remaining sheep have been removed the Council has agreed to have the fencing around the perimeter of the inner field removed and is arranging consultation with third parties on management areas of the site going forward. A further update will be given at the November Council meeting

Christmas Draw Saturday 23rd December Please see bar staff to pay and enter the draw (entry for members only) Over the past few years the growth of stinging nettles and thistles has proliferated. The sheep don't really like them and the farmer is having to give them food supplements to keep them healthy. After 25 odd years the fencing is now in need of repair – which could be costly.

Hence, the feeling that some change is due. The sheep are currently being removed by the farmer – not that easy to catch apparently. Next, the fence will be taken down – also not that easy due to the presence of a fair bit of barbed wire. After that it's open to ideas and agreement from the village.

An easy first step would be to cut some more pathways through the grass and move some of the picnic tables further into the site to encourage wider and easier public access for residents to sit and enjoy the surroundings. A substantial amount of the land will still be left wild and in its natural state.

What else happens will depend on how much interest and support comes forward to help out. For example, we could introduce more native plants and flowers to encourage insects, birds and animals.

The Parish Council will have a budget for safety and maintenance work but any more work may require some volunteer work. Expert advice is currently being taken so exactly what needs to be done will be shared later in our next update. Healing Green Agenda Group

Our Moated Settlement Site – It's Future Use

The time has come for the Healing Moated Settlement to undergo a serious review. This 6 acre area is of archaeological interest being the site of a former mediaeval community linked to the main moated manor house where the Healing Manor now stands.

Following the excavation of a large flood balance pond by the housing estate builders, which destroyed a fair bit of the site, it was properly surveyed and listed as a medieval site by English Heritage and Historic England in 1994. This protected it from any future building or development work.

In 1999 the builders gave the land to the Heritage Trust of Lincolnshire

"to be managed as an ancient monument and as an amenity for the residents of Healing".

Restoration work was carried out by the Healing Time Team in association with Operation Lifestyle. A group of residents formed the Friends of the Moated Settlement to help look after the site which they did very well for many years and undertook a substantial amount of very hard work.

The Heritage Trust arranged for a flock of rare breed sheep to be kept there to keep the grass under control. Obviously, a fence had to be constructed to stop them from just wandering off. This worked very well at first and definitely added interest to the village.

In 2009 the Heritage Trust wanted to step back from ownership and offered the site for sale so it was bought by the Parish Council. The Parish Council had a Stewardship Agreement in place for many years with Natural England but that then was ceased.

Being an archaeological site, extensive tree planting is not allowed but where there are no remains in the ground then perhaps some tree planting may be viable.
