HEALING PARISH COUNCIL NOTES FOR OCTOBER 2021

The Council meeting for September 2021 was scheduled to be held at the Hall as usual but unfortunately, due to holidays and then last-minute illnesses, there were not enough members to be quorate and so the meeting was not held.

Highways and Footpaths

NELC has completed its repairs to Great Coates Road and the new configuration for the junction with Low Road. The next stage will be a consultation over parking around the Primary School and suggestions to ease the situation. This is expected to be received hopefully before Christmas 2021.

Planning Applications

The planning applications considered at the meeting for the last meeting were not discussed due to the meeting not being quorate.

Land Management Issues

The grass path around the Moated Site has now been cut, the long grass is still being left around the remaining area next to the path to promote wildlife and enhance the natural features of the site.

Nettles on the main inner field will also soon be cut down.

Other works to trees have now been completed with trees at Porri's Wood overhanging the path to school cut back and the willow tree on the path at the Moated Site also cut back.

Other Items

The Parish Council has registered to take part in the Platinum Jubilee Event in 2022 and will be lighting a beacon along with others nationally and also holding an event to commemorate this important occasion.

Continued....

The Council has started its planning for the Remembrance Day event in 2021 and is organising meetings with the Royal British Legion to confirm details for the event.

A Christmas event is also being discussed and any arrangements will be finalised in the next two months.

Police Matters

The Parish Council continues to receive its monthly police report, which is published in the News each month.

Village Hall

The Hall is still fully operational for all our regular hirings and is available for children's parties, other celebrations etc. and will remain fully operational whilst the new facility is being built.

Village Hall project

The building of the new hall is now two months into the project and it is anticipated that works will be finished somewhere around mid-November, with the Hall being fully opened in time for Christmas 2021.

Finance

The Parish Council has now had its financial audit signed off by the external auditor with no actions recommended. All paperwork for this is on the website as is all finance information.

- ✓ Water should be readily available to control the fire. If the fire becomes out of control call 999 immediately and ask for the fire service
- ✗ Never use accelerants on a bonfire, i.e. petrol, paraffin or aerosols

We actively encourage the public to attend an organised display

- ✓ Keep everyone at a safe distance during celebrations
- ✗ Never leave fireworks unattended. Never go back to a firework once it has been lit
- ✓ If using sparklers, always wear gloves
- ✓ Keep pets inside during bonfire and firework celebrations

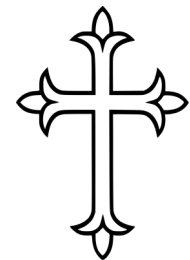
