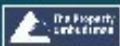

Presentation received from Etridge architects and members of Council and public asked questions.

Objections – admirable design and noted environmental points, but proximity to Church and Churchyard was felt to be not in keeping with area. Over intensification of the site also with such large scale and size. Concerns on access with users of approach road including Healing Manor.

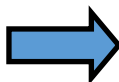

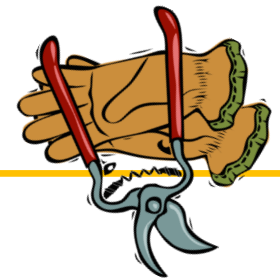
Hedge and Tree Maintenance

The Parish Council is in the process of updating its Emergency Plan for Healing and is looking to update details of residents who may need some extra help in an emergency situation and looking to record details of residents who can offer some help, no matter how little. The following is a letter to all residents with details. Please either complete the form and return to us or a Council member who may live near you, or email the Clerk with the details.

Emergency Plan

Healing Parish Council is in the process of preparing a basic emergency plan, so that as a community we can help ourselves if something was to happen in our village. Checking on vulnerable people, collecting provisions and prescriptions, helping move property and furniture, clearing snow and providing shelter, warmth and food and drinks are the kind of things that we think we can do to help people affected by the emergency.

We are appealing to you for your help. Would you be willing to help out during an emergency? Do you have any particular skills or equipment that you think might be of use? Do you belong to a community group that might be able to help during an emergency, such as luncheon groups or crèches? If the answer is yes – and you would like to do something to help your community - we would very much like to hear from you. Please complete the form on the back of this letter, or give our Clerk a call or send us an email. There are no obligations on anyone that volunteers – it will just mean that we may call you in an emergency to ask if you are free to help.

We would also like to hear from you if you think you might need support during an emergency. Please complete the form on the back of this letter, and we will do our best to contact you in an emergency to see if you are ok.
